MCAP PARTICIPATES IN NATIONAL SYMPOSIUM

MCAP representatives Peggy Cairns and Eva Murphy were among 350 people who attended, in person, the national symposium, OUT OF THE SHADOWS: CONFRONTING THE RISE OF CHILD-ON-CHILD HARMFUL SEXUAL BEHAVIOR, hosted by the National Center on Sexual Exploitation. Two days of presentations by social workers, educators, government officials, law enforcement, psychologists, and other child safety experts, with so much to hear documenting the enormous and growing role played by pornography that contributes to minors committing sexual abuse on other minors. A re-cap is available online here outlining brief highlights and standouts. Innovative strategies were discussed for what can be done to address the problem were put forward, showing reasons for hope. Support and rehabilitation need to be widely available for both the victims and the perpetrators. As one speaker, Professor Mary Anne Layden said, "therapy is good, prevention is better." MCAP was pleased to host an exhibit table with educational resource materials, and to be able to meet others with whom to network.

Online Toolkit to Raise Porn Resilient Kids

A dynamic *free* parental resource online <u>program</u> released earlier this year by the **Culture Reframed** organization. Because kids are just a click away from hypersexualized media and porn, this complete, best-practice toolkit was developed to help parents raise porn-resilient kids. It includes culturally competent, research-driven, age-based educational videos, downloads and resource links. Three modules are aimed, respectively, for Teens, Tweens, and Children, with facilitation for guided conversations with youth.

BARK - Parental Control Smart Phone Tracker App

A parental control smart phone tracker app being used by concerned parents who are finding invaluable to monitor troublesome content and unwise behavior: **BARK**. Busy parents cannot read every text message, post, and email. Created in collaboration with child psychologists, youth advisors, digital media experts, and law enforcement professionals, Bark delivers a kid-friendly solution for safeguarding families as technology changes. It proactively monitors text messages, YouTube, emails, and 24 different social networks for potential safety concerns about sexting, cyberbullying, and remarks indicating suicidal/self-harm, violence, use of controlled substances, and mental health problems. Bark has won awards from The National Parenting Center, Mom's Choice Awards, and National Parenting Product Awards. Works on iOS, Android, and Amazon mobile devices. \$9/month; *join with the code* **MCAP1** *to sign up for a free 1-month trial*.

Facebook group - "Parenting in a Tech World"

There is also a related Facebook group, Parenting in a Tech World, where participants are sharing tips and wisdom, posing questions, and listening to answers from others who have dealt with common issues and experiences. Currently, as of this writing, the group has 30,481 members and is seeing multiple postings daily stimulating great discussions and a support network. If you are feeling frustrated from a child's online craziness, you are definitely not alone, and there is strength in numbers!
