### What the Maryland General Assembly is considering in 2025

Another busy legislative season in Annapolis is upon us!

We are most excited about the pending bill MCAP asked to be sponsored, the <u>Safer Devices for Kids</u> Act, <u>HB 1212</u>. THANK YOU Delegate Susan McComas for reintroducing it, in an improved model form from last year, and to the 2 national organizations, NCOSE (the National Center On Sexual Exploitation) and PYE (Protect Young Eyes), who carefully crafted it so that it will pass constitutional muster and have a minimal impact on the free speech rights of adults. Its hearing will be on Feb. 25, which means anyone wishing to submit written comments or oral testimony must sign up by Feb. 21.

Testifying is one of the most powerful ways you can influence the legislature. If you want to testify on any of these bills, be sure to sign up by the time on the chart below. You can also consult the House and Senate policies for the testimony deadlines. Witness sign—up will be open online from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. through the Maryland General Assembly website two business days before the bill hearing. You need to create a "MyMGA" account. Click <a href="here">here</a> for a tutorial, and scroll down for the video on "Witness signup." Note, the website does not support Internet Explorer. Please use another web browser.



A new Maryland law that is taking effect this year is the "Maryland Kids Code" affecting internet safety and privacy rights. It requires new social media accounts to be set to private as a default. It would also implement strategies to prevent strangrs from contacting children online.
